(Maroon colour with school monogram)</li><li>➤ 'V' neck pullover and half sweater with golden stripes and the school monogram are common for all classes.</li></ul>	

1. School visiting hours for Parents is from 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.
2. Students must be punctual. They should come to school at least five minutes before the school starts.
3. School uniform is compulsory and students shall come to school wearing the prescribed uniform. They shall come clean and tidy.
4. Students are not allowed to meet parents or visitors or to leave the school premises during school hours without the permission of the Principal. Only in case of emergency, it is compulsory for the parents / guardians to come and collect their ward.
5. Pupils should bring to class all necessary text books and note books according to the time table. Non-approved books or magazines should not be brought to the school.
6. No student should be absent without leave previously approved, except in case of unforeseen circumstances applications for leave must be submitted on the following day. Students remaining absent for one or two days must give leave information through students diary duly signed by parents.
7. Repeated absence without leave application or unexplained absence for more than three consecutive months renders the students liable to have his/her name struck off from the register. Re-admission may be granted only on payment of fresh admission fee.
8. Medical certificate is compulsory for continuous absence for more than three days.
9. Students with 100% attendance will be awarded on the first day of the new session (late comers and half day leave will not be considered for the same).
10. **Students of Class X and XII will not be allowed to fill up the LOC as per CBSE guidelines without 75% attendance.**
11. Students should follow the PTM schedule. Students should come in proper **school uniform on PTM.**
12. Students are expected to keep the school premises clean. They are forbidden to write or scribble on walls, throw paper or ink around the classroom or in any way to damage the school properties. Any such act will entail Punishment and recovery of cost.
13. Students are themselves responsible for their books, money, Tiffin carriers and other articles. It is not advisable for students to have money or valuable articles with them.

14. There will be full class on the last day of every month. There will be no classes on Saturdays for class I, II, XI & XII.
- 15. Students who have morning assembly should reach school by 7:30 AM to participate in the morning exercise as per CBSE instructions.**
16. A compulsory medical inspection of all students will be conducted once a year by qualified medical officer.
17. Students suffering from infectious/contagious diseases (**Chicken pox, Measles, Mumps, Jaundice, etc**) will not be allowed to attend school. Only on production of a **medical certificate from a medical officer** and observation of 21 days, where necessary, they will be allowed to return to school.
- 18. Attendance on the First day of Academic session, Annual function, Annual sports and School Outing is compulsory for classes I - XII.**
19. Parents should not enter the classroom during school hours.
20. Parents Cooperation is solicited in maintaining the sanctity and security of the school. All instructions issued from time to time should be carefully complied with.
